Leave a Legacy to MiD

Many of our supporters who wish to give financial support to MiD are prevented from doing so by everyday commitments. Leaving a gift in your Will does not burden you during your lifetime and is quick and simple to arrange.

By leaving a legacy to MiD you can help to ensure that our resources are available to future generations.

If you are thinking about leaving a gift to MiD in your Will, the best thing to do is see your solicitor. He/she will be able to advise you how to write — or amend — your Will, and how to make a legacy to charities like MiD. There are a number of ways you might want to remember MiD in your Will.

If you choose to leave a gift in your Will for MiD's general purposes, set out below are examples of some suggested wording:

"I give to MiD Mediation & Counselling, 114 High Street, Hampton Hill TW12 1NT, Registered Charity No. 1076166, to be applied for the general purposes of MiD Mediation and Counselling the sum of (amount in figures and words) and I direct the receipt of a proper officer for the time being of MiD Mediation and Counselling shall be a complete discharge to my Executors"

Many people prefer not to leave a stated amount of money to charity, but rather to leave a share of the residue of their estate. In this case the following wording may be helpful:

"I give all/a share of (please state fraction or percentage) the residue of my estate absolutely to MiD Mediation & Counselling, 114 High Street, Hampton Hill TW12 1NT, Registered Charity 1076166, to be applied for the general purposes of MiD Mediation and Counselling and I direct the receipt of a proper officer for the time being of MiD Mediation and Counselling shall be a complete discharge to my Executors"
